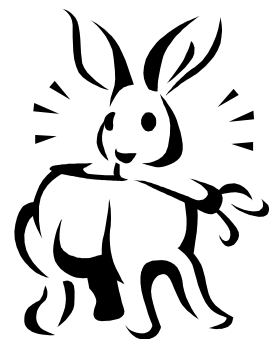

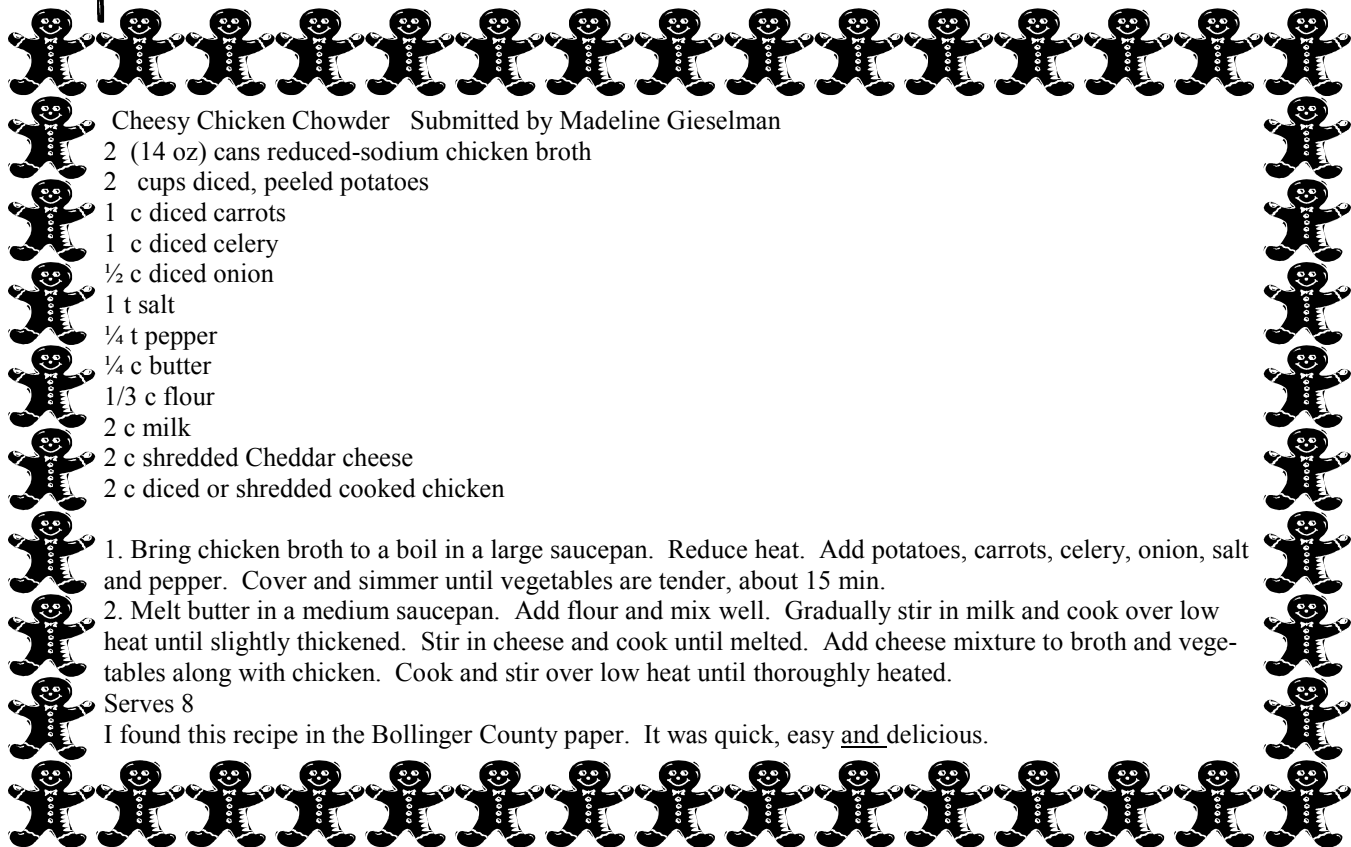

Tips, Recipes, and Notes



Cheesy Chicken Chowder Submitted by Madeline Gieselman

- 2 (14 oz) cans reduced-sodium chicken broth
- 2 cups diced, peeled potatoes
- 1 c diced carrots
- 1 c diced celery
- ½ c diced onion
- 1 t salt
- ¼ t pepper
- ¼ c butter
- 1/3 c flour
- 2 c milk
- 2 c shredded Cheddar cheese
- 2 c diced or shredded cooked chicken

1. Bring chicken broth to a boil in a large saucepan. Reduce heat. Add potatoes, carrots, celery, onion, salt and pepper. Cover and simmer until vegetables are tender, about 15 min.
2. Melt butter in a medium saucepan. Add flour and mix well. Gradually stir in milk and cook over low heat until slightly thickened. Stir in cheese and cook until melted. Add cheese mixture to broth and vegetables along with chicken. Cook and stir over low heat until thoroughly heated.

Serves 8

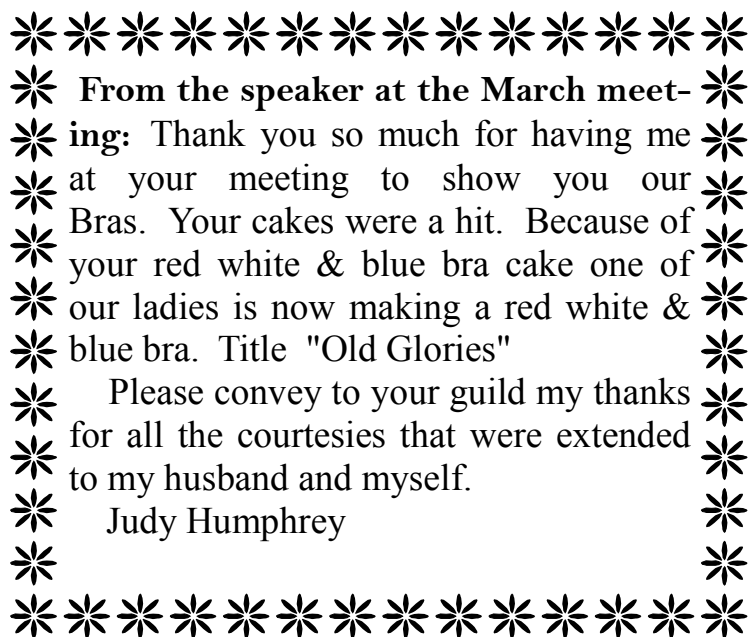

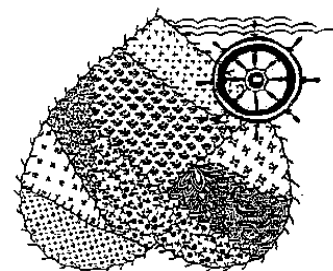
