Bring items to sell in the “trunk sale” if you like.

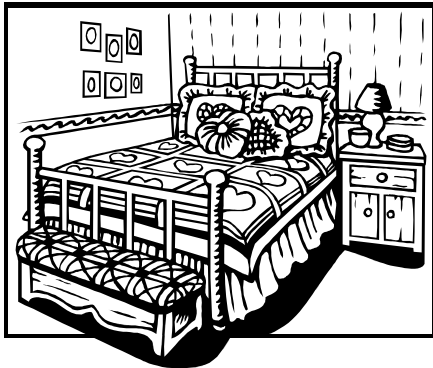
WANTED:

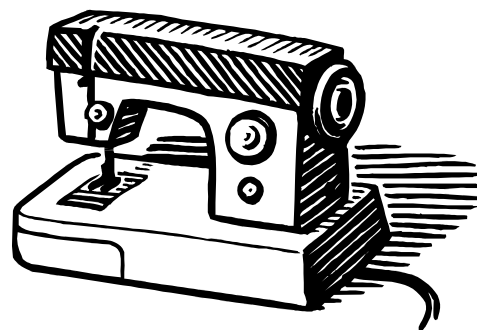

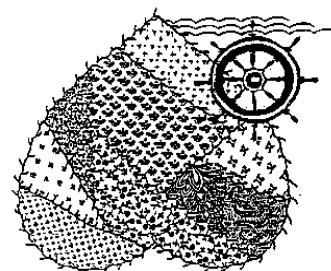
