Workshop Spots Available:

Ladies: If you missed our July meeting, you may not be aware of our August guest, Lynn Cibulka. She is an innovative quilt/pattern designer and offers unique ideas and techniques. She will be sharing a trunk show at the evenings meeting, as well as offering a Monday morning and/or Monday afternoon workshop. The workshop will be held at the Library in the same room as our meetings. The morning session will begin at 9:30-12:00 noon and the afternoon session will be between 1:00 - 4:00 pm. The cost is \$12.00 for either the morning or afternoon; however, if you would like to spend the full day, it's only \$20. The featured workshop will be on an original Halloween/Fall pattern. Morning will be a 12" square (plus borders) of a pieced Witches' Boot; the afternoon will be a 24" x 60" table runner called Swept Away. Both pieces are part of her full wall hanging pattern which includes flying geese and pinwheels and borders. So, you may have 2 separate projects or put them together for a larger one.

We certainly do have openings if you would like to attend. If you have a friend that is not a guild member, we welcome them to attend also.

All I ask is that you contact me so I may add your names to the list. When you send me your fee, I will forward your supply list with a picture of the project. .. or if you have already signed up, you may pay me (discreetly) during the workshop. Nevertheless, your supply list and photo will soon be sent to you.
