Paper Piecing Inspirations by Janet Wickell

Ever wanted to try paper piecing but did not want to get involved in a big project? The easiest blocks are those made of rectangles only, such as a log cabin. http://quilting.about.com/od/foundationpiecing/ss/log_cabin_block.htm. She has several patterns for small foundation pieced projects, such as the Windmill Quilt at left below that makes a 21 inch square wall hanging. For someone wanting a bigger challenge, try the pattern on the right at <http://quilting.about.com/od/miniaturequilts/ss/oddfelows.htm>. This quilt is 20 inches on each side.
