

# Free Pattern for a Quilt of Valor - by Kevin the Quilter

Each block in this quilt requires:

1: 2.5"x12.5" strip

&

1: 11"x12.5" piece of contrasting fabric

**Mix and match the following solid colors (or colors that read as solid):**

**Blues:** Navy to Light Blue (excluding blue greens or turquoise)

**Reds:** Bright Red to Deep Rich Red (excluding pinkish reds and burgundy)

**Gold:** Bright Yellow Gold to Deep Harvest Gold

**Neutrals:** Whites to Tans, excluding brown

**To make the block:**

- Cut a straight line vertically on the 11" side of the larger piece of fabric. Make the cut anywhere you would like.
- Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew the strip to both sides of cut pieces of larger fabric.
- Set seams, and press AWAY from the strip.

**Tips:**

Placing the strip in various locations within the block adds interest.

Make sure to cut a straight line vertically on the 11" side of the larger piece of fabric. **DO NOT** cut on the 12.5" side. The unfinished block measures 12.5" when sewn together, and then can be rotated within the quilt top. A 5 block by 6 block layout will create a quilt approximately 60"x72", perfect for a Quilt of Valor.
