_____ **1. Group, Large Quilt**
(At least 60 in. x 80 in. or a
minimum perimeter of 280 inches)

_____ **2. Group, Small Quilt**
(Smaller than 60 in. x 80 in. or a
perimeter less than 280 inches.)

INDIVIDUAL Categories: (only one person worked on the quilt):

_____ **3. Large Quilt** (any technique)
(at least 60 in. x 80 in. or a minimum
perimeter of 280 inches.)

_____ **4. Wall Hanging** (any technique,
larger than 25 in. x 25 in., maximum
size 80 in. x 80 in.)

5. _____ **Modern Quilt** (anything NOT
traditional in color, style, quilting, i.e. art
quilts, landscapes, negative space, etc.,
larger than 25 x 25 inches., maximum
size 80 x 80 in.)

_____ **6. Small Wall Quilt** (any technique,
25 in. x 25 in. or less)

_____ **7. Quilt Show Theme Wall Hanging** (follows theme of current show, size is minimum
perimeter of 96 inches and maximum perimeter of 192 inches. For example, the completed quilt
can measure no larger than 48 in. x 48 in. or smaller than 24 in. x 24 in.--or variations thereof.)

_____ **8. Youth** (18 year or under, can be made by a group. This entry will receive a ribbon but
will not be judged. There is no entry fee for the Youth Category.)

Contest Rules

1. Contest is open to legal residents of Missouri, Illinois, Kentucky, Tennessee, Arkansas; or any member of River Heritage Quilt Guild.
2. Quilt must have been finished since 2016 and be in excellent condition.
3. Quilt must be constructed and quilted by the person or persons named on the entry blank. *If you are entering the group category, please list all persons who worked on this quilt. If someone quilted this quilt for you, their name goes on the list, and the quilt belongs in a Group category.)*
4. All quilt entries are to be made by **one person**-- except in Group Quilt categories.
5. Limit of **TWO** quilts entered per category.
6. Mailed quilts must be received from Monday, September 17th through Friday, September 21st. If hand delivering your quilt, it must be received **on** Thursday, September 27 at the **Golden Needle, 303 S. Kingshighway**, Cape Girardeau between the hours of 10 am and 3 pm. Quilts will be displayed on September 29th and 30th.
7. A slide-through type hanging method must be attached to the back of the quilt to provide easy hanging of the quilt. Failure to attach a slide-through hanging method as follows will disqualify your entry:

Categories 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 8: Hanging method to accommodate a **6-inch rod**.

Category 6 (Small Wall): Hanging method to accommodate a **2- inch rod**.

Category 7: Show Theme: Hanging method to accommodate a **4-inch rod**.

8. A photograph of your quilt must be included with the entry blank.
9. Each quilt entered needs to be placed in a pillow case (or other fabric case) and identified with the name, address, and telephone number of the entrant. Unless quilts are being mailed, please omit boxes and or plastic bags.
10. All quilts must be registered by Monday, September 12. There is a \$5 entry fee for each quilt entered. This fee must be included with your Entry Blank when registering your quilt for the show. Space is limited, so we will stop taking entries when our number of quilt spaces is filled. Please submit a separate Entry Blank for each quilt. Print and fill in a copy of this form for each quilt. **Make checks payable to RHQG.**

11. River Heritage Quilters Guild reserves the right to reject any quilt that we feel does not meet the standards we have set for the Show.

12. Each quilt must be permanently identified on the back of the quilt with your name and the title of the quilt.

13. A one day Complementary Pass will be given to each person entering quilts.

15. Shipping Information: All contest quilts must **arrive** to the River Heritage Quilters Guild of Cape Girardeau between the dates of Monday, September 24 and Wednesday, September 26. Ship the quilt to us in a strong, reusable, cardboard carton. We suggest you wrap the quilts in plastic and tape then tightly to prevent any possible water damage during shipping. When preparing the carton for shipping, do not use the word "Quilt" on the outside of the box. Please attach your name and address to the quilt.
